We Need Your Name to End Tooth Decay

For over a decade, our small group has discussed how to prevent or minimize the harm from tooth decay and its treatment. We call ourselves EnDK Advocates (End Dee Cay).

We have tried new measures, conducted research and performed demonstration projects around the world—even on a sidewalk in San Francisco. Members of our group have obtained FDA device and medication approvals; developed tooth decay risk tests; invented three essential tools that don't require public utilities; published articles; assembled an online library; and written textbooks. We have made many presentations, including a TED talk. We submitted a \$100 million, competitive MacArthur Foundation grant proposal to care for 600,000 individuals worldwide for 5 years. It wasn't selected but we will resubmit a greatly improved proposal for the anticipated 2023 competition.

Why do we need your name as an EnDK Advocate? The U.S. Surgeon General and the World Health Organization have labeled tooth decay the *silent* pandemic, because it isn't a fatal disease. Our MacArthur grant proposal asked for evidence that there is a strong, global demand to stop tooth decay. This is why we need children, parents, health professionals, educators, social workers, friends, neighbors and sympathetic organizations to register their names as evidence of a strong demand to make tooth decay a **NOISY** pandemic.

Narrative

Dental caries (tooth decay) occurs when bacteria turn sugar into acid that dissolves enamel and dentin, resulting in cavities, toothaches and tooth extractions.

Conventional treatment (drill & fill, remove & replace) costs \$600 billion annually but doesn't prevent or control the disease. Over three billion people have no access to care and their untreated cavities lead to excruciating toothaches.

The best lifelong preventive methods are to minimize sugary snacks/drinks and optimize use of fluoride. If unsuccessful, then harm can be limited by using World Health Organization's "essential dental preparations" – topical fluorides, glass ionomer cement and silver diamine fluoride. These preparations are safe, effective, painless (no needles or drills), easy to apply, non-invasive, low-cost, equitable, sustainable and time-efficient.

The shift, from surgery & repair to self-help & medical management, requires bold action, innovation, cooperation, and perseverance. We want to accelerate this shift through discussion, demonstration projects, public education, collaboration and political action.
